Five years ago we took on an ambitious vision to deepen our impact by opening an Early Learning Center. After a year of construction, we opened our doors to the first cohort of little learners. Now, four years later, this same class is getting ready to attend pre-kindergarten, with some of our "graduates" heading off to wonderful elementary schools. In keeping with the Epiphany model, we have expanded our Graduate Support Program to ensure our students stay on positive trajectories. This includes making sure they have great after-school and summer programming as well as whatever help their parents need to keep their children on the path of success. With the ELC, our work begins during pregnancy and will continue through to college and into the workforce. Staying in touch with our graduates not only serves them, it also helps us assess our impact and continually improve what we do. It has been an incredible journey to see them grow and learn.

# THE WEEK OF THE YOUNG CHILD

This year, we hosted The Week of the Young Child (WOYC), an annual celebration of the youngest learners. The purpose of the WOYC is to focus public attention on the needs of young children and their families and to recognize the early childhood programs and services that meet those needs. Our children learned so much as they enjoyed music, explored food and cooking, built together, created art, and celebrated families! Huge thanks to our terrific teachers who planned an incredible week including:

## Music MONDAY

**When children sing, dance, and listen to music, they develop their language and early literacy skills while being active.** Here are some of the song requests we got from families and students. We played them throughout the day in the classroom and outdoors...

## Tasty TUESDAY

**Cooking together connects math with literacy skills, science, and more.** After a class vote, pizza was declared the children's top favorite food to eat with their families. We took a trip to our local pizza shop, Charlie's House of Pizza on Dorchester Avenue, where the staff showed us the different ingredients they used to make their pizza. The children had an opportunity to touch the dough, smell the different spices, and even taste the delicious pizza.



## Working Together WEDNESDAY

**When children build together they explore math and science concepts and develop their social and early literacy skills.** As a class, we worked together to build a fort using bars and ball connectors. The children used vocabulary words we learned in previous units such as base, building, construction workers, roof, etc. We learned that when working together we may need to share, take turns, be helpful, and communicate with one another.



## Artsy THURSDAY

**Think, problem solve and create! Children develop creativity, social skills, and fine motor skills with open-ended art projects where they can make choices, use their imaginations, and create with their hands.** We rotated through various creative centers where the children freely moved between each activity as they pleased. Some involved teamwork and communication where in other activities children worked individually. The students created as they listened to flute music by a Native American musician, Mary Youngblood, which we discussed during Circle Time.



## Family FRIDAY

**Engaging and celebrating families is at the heart of supporting our youngest learners. We applaud family members' roles as young children's first and most important teachers.** We celebrated our families with each child sharing their favorite thing to do with their family. Here are some of their responses:

## INNOVATION AND GROWTH

Each year, Epiphany brings in outside evaluators to assess an aspect of the Middle School's curriculum. This helps us hold ourselves accountable to high standards and continuously examine what, and how, we teach.

This past year, we had the pleasure of welcoming Jay T. Moody, PhD, Innovation Coach from Wayland High School and Sue Austin, MS Faculty, Milton Academy to our campus to assess the Science Department. (Thank you both so much!)

**Below are some highlights from their review:**

The Science Department is adept at using technology in the classroom. For example, the interactive Smart Boards allow for seamless transitions between activities. The students also have access to Chromebooks, online resources, makerspace, and more, and the staff are well-versed in the use of technology in the classroom. In addition, there seems to be a seamless integration of iPads for data collection in the greenhouse space, and there is substantial use of online tools such as Phet, Nearpod, and other useful applications for virtual learning and simulations.

Vis-à-vis the curriculum, there is a clear connection between the content covered in the science units and the projects completed. Students engage often with projects ranging from creating models to researching and constructing informative pamphlets to educate others. The process of completing them reinforces the content taught during each unit. The teachers work incredibly hard to engage students when learning the content.

It was evident from the moment we stepped into the different classrooms how dedicated this faculty is to creating an engaging learning environment.

We observed many examples of real-world application connections. We saw it during the 5th-grade lesson, 6th-grade climate change lesson, and out in the garden! There was an excellent connection between classroom lessons and real-world situations and activities. The 6th-grade water quality lesson's connection to Flint, Michigan, for instance. Turning the lessons on climate change, water quality, and air quality into action-inspiring words during the Poetry Slam was moving.

**The behavior of the students was truly outstanding.**

Eager participation in the 5th-grade classroom was wonderful to see. ***Epiphany is doing amazing things for students, families, and the community as a whole.*** This is truly a special place, and we feel fortunate to have visited it. We were impressed by the dedication of the faculty to wear many hats and to be truly invested in the concept of "Never give up on a child."

# OUR AMAZING GRADUATES

Our Graduate Support Program honors our ongoing commitment to our graduates with high school placement, summer jobs, individualized post-secondary planning, “last dollar” scholarships, college guidance, and career readiness programming. This year, for example, we provided the 7th and 8th graders with our My Career & Academic Plan class where students appreciate their strengths and weaknesses and how those should inform their high school, college, and career trajectories. In addition, every student receives individualized high school placement support to find schools that are the right fit for them. For our graduates in high school, as always, we provided substantial support both in-person and remotely – e.g., monthly virtual meetings, one-on-one check-ins, regular calls with guidance counselors, and office hours. We also continued to offer workshops on financial literacy and career readiness through our partners like Invest in Girls who provided their workshops virtually. With access to this abiding support and resources, our graduates are finding success and outperforming their peers.

## OUR TEACHING FELLOWS PROGRAM

A rich and engaging academic experience is at the center of what we do, and the Teaching Fellows Program contributes greatly to the success of Epiphany's students. These Fellows support Lead Teachers in the classroom and receive free room and board on our campus along with monthly stipends, healthcare, and \$6,500 a year off their student loans, thanks to our partners at AmeriCorps. They also often have the opportunity to earn a free master's degree with the Donovan Scholars program at Boston College's Lynch School of Education. Through this special teacher training program, which is especially accessible to people from our community, Epiphany addresses the need to train the next generation of great urban educators while helping our students make accelerated academic progress. Fellows work closely with our students, leading small reading enrichment book groups, mentoring, and helping us differentiate instruction. Most of our Fellows are from the same backgrounds as our students, and many are themselves Epiphany graduates.

# RESULTS

From the infants in the ELC to our graduates out in the world, we are proud of every member of the Epiphany community. We are always looking for ways to improve our methods and rely on a range of assessments to show us what works and to identify areas that need additional support.

## THE EARLY LEARNING CENTER

### OUR YOUNGEST LEARNERS

We utilize the ASQ (Ages and Stages Questionnaire), a wonderful tool that allows our teachers to assess which children are meeting or exceeding developmental benchmarks, and which ones require additional intervention. The most recent round of assessments yielded great news: **95%** of the children are meeting or exceeding benchmarks for fine motor skills, gross motor skills, and personal and social skills, and those who require additional early intervention will get the help they need to graduate “kindergarten ready.”

## THE MIDDLE SCHOOL

### STANFORD 10

As in the past, all the children in the Middle School took the Stanford 10 in fall and spring of last year. Despite the challenges of living with our COVID protocols, in just nine months of instructional time, they made an **average of 1.3 years of growth in Reading and 2.2 years of growth in Math!**



### THE SOCIAL-EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT OF OUR MIDDLE SCHOOLERS

At Epiphany, character and social-emotional development matter just as much as academic achievement, and we continue to use the Holistic Student Assessment (HSA) to assess student social-emotional growth. Students take the HSA once at the beginning of the school year and once at the end to evaluate Resiliency, Relationships, and Learning & School Engagement. For the second year in a row “School Bonding” remains our students’ number one strength, which is a testament to the incredible relationship-building work accomplished by our faculty and staff.

We must, however, remember that Epiphany depends on the generosity of all of us. I truly hope that everyone will continue to support the school to the best of their ability."*

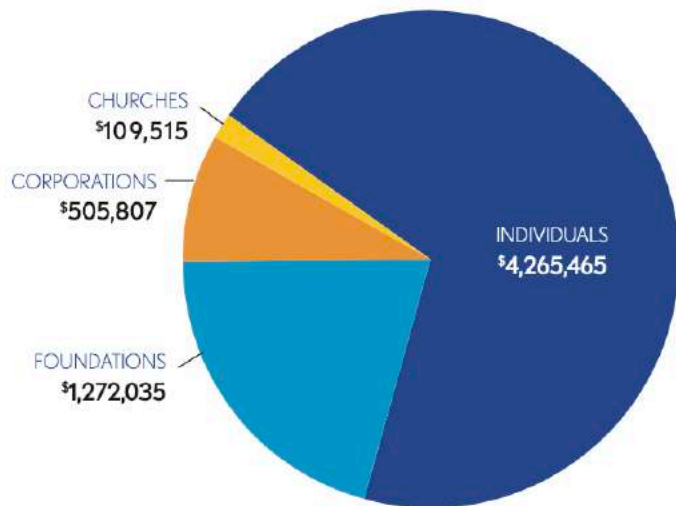

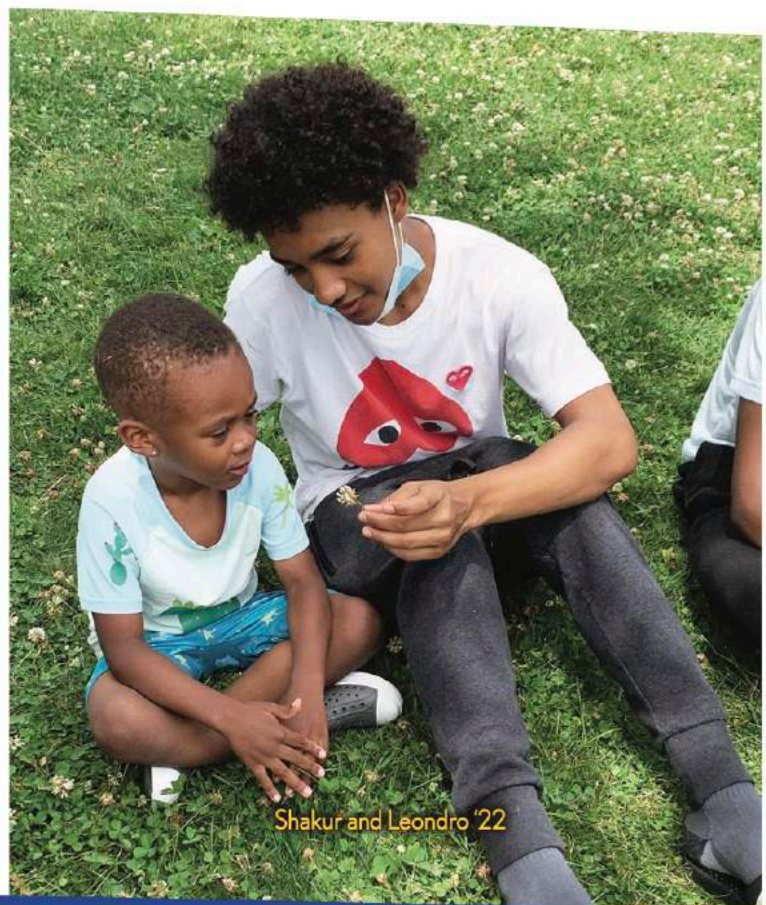
